## **Small Group Questions**

#### 1. Getting Started:

- What did you find most interesting about the sermon this week? The most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?

### 2. Into the Bible (2 Corinthians 3:7-18)

- V. 7-11: What does Paul mean by "the ministry of the Spirit"? (Check Romans 8:9-17 and Galatians 5:16-25) Why is it better than Moses' ministry?
- V. 12-13: Why did Moses need to wear a veil? How are we different from Moses, according to Paul?

• V. 14-17: Why can the non-Christian Israelites see the truth behind the Law? How can their veil be removed?

• V. 18: What are Christians able to because we are no longer veiled? What are we being changed into?

### 3. Going Deeper

- We are called to be like God, who is gracious, merciful, slow to anger and full of loyal love. Which of those character traits is the hardest for you to adopt?
- What would you need to change in the way you treat other people in order to reflect God's character?
