


With NYSERDA you save thousands on new EV chargers

Understanding "Charge Ready NY"

The Charge Ready NY rebate from NYSERDA is a result of Gov. Cuomo's "Charge NY 2.0" initiative, in which he vowed to invest in programs that will help promote the use of clean energy. One way Cuomo's initiative hopes to do that is by installing 10,000 stations across New York by 2021. As a result, organization like NYSERDA have been given the funding to help thousands of New Yorkers get the EV charging stations their communities need.



What you get from the program

The way this rebate is structured is fairly straightforward —you install a station, NYSERDA gives you money. More stations = more money. How much? Well, to put it simply:

1 port = \$4,000

Easy, right? So, for example, if you install one EVBox Iqon, that would be \$8,000 in rebates.

Locations can receive funding for up to 20 ports (\$80-\$90K), and organizations with multiple locations can receive up to \$200,000 in funding per year.



Who qualifies

The objective of this program is to expand the network of public and semi-public charging stations, thereby making it easier for EV drivers to stay charged up. The logic here is pretty self-explanatory:

more EV chargers = more EV drivers = less gas cars = cleaner air

So, if you're looking to get EV charging anyplace where it's not for single person use, odds are this program is for you.

But just to double check, here are the specific qualifications and requirements as listed by NYSERDA:



Who qualifies



Public parking (Networked stations only)

- 10+ parking spots
- Open 12+ hours, 5+ days/week
- E.g., municipal lots, parking garages, retail locations, malls, restaurants, parks, train/bus stations

Workplace (Networked stations only)

- 10+ parking spots
- Serve 15+ employees
- E.g., office building, universities, schools, hospitals





Multi-unit housing (Networked or Network-ready stations)

- 8+ parking spots
- 5+ housing units served
- 50% resident vehicles between 7pm-7am
- E.g., apartment building, condominiums, co-ops
