Secretary JoElla Haffner Cell: 765-230-0800 The story recently came up in conversation about how, well over a century ago, the women of New Market grew fed up with the saloon in town, and burned it to the ground. It's an impressive story, and brings to mind the zeal of another woman, who over 250 years ago did something which may have singlehandedly sparked the explosion of Methodism in North America.

Her name was Barbara Heck, and though you may have never heard of her, she is known as the Mother of the Methodist Church in America. Heck had converted to Methodism in Ireland at the preach-

ing of John Wesley, and in 1860 emigrated to New York City with several other members of her community – Germans who had settled in Ireland half a century earlier. Among her fellow emigrants was Philip Embury, an early Methodist "local preacher."

Cut off from Methodist influences, the New York Methodists lost their fervor and had even stopped having regular meetings. That all changed one night in 1766, when Heck walked in on a group of men from her community playing cards. She grabbed the cards, tossed them into the fireplace, and reproached the men for their sinfulness. She then went directly to Embury and told him that if he did not begin preaching to the people, their damnation would be on his head.

Her words moved Embury, who went on to establish arguably the first Methodist church in North America (Robert Strawbridge was leading a Methodist congregation in Maryland by this point also). His work sowed the seeds for the growth of Methodism in and around New York.

With the coming of the Revolutionary War, Heck and her family, who were Tories, moved to Canada, where they facilitated the growth of Methodism yet again. As we all know, the Methodist church went on to spread rapidly as the frontier moved westward. What we can easily forget is that, in many ways, it began when one pious woman interrupted a card game and demanded accountability from her community.




