Text: Titus 2:11-15

Title: The Gospel of Grace the Fountain of Christian Life and Duty IV

Introduction

- I. The grand sweep of the power and effect of an experience of saving grace in Jesus Christ.
  - A. Grace teaches by direction in the way of holiness of life.
  - B. Grace teaches both to depart from evil and to do good.
  - C. Grace teaches us to renounce evil - to renounce all sin.
- II. The Apostle addresses ungodliness and worldly lusts to be denied.
  - A. What does the Apostle say is the first thing to be *denied*?
  - B. What is it to "deny ungodliness"?
- III. Helps in denying all ungodliness
  - A. Make no exceptions of ungodliness.
  - B. Examine your heart for hidden ungodliness.
  - C. Earnestly pray that the desire of your heart for the Lord to show you anything which grieves His Spirit be made known to you.

**Westminster Shorter Catechism #73:** *What is the eighth commandment? The eighth commandment is: You shall not steal.*

Children who have not publicly confessed Christ by being received by the Session into communicant Church membership should refrain from the Sacrament and learn by reverent observation; this, even though they may already have received Christ privately. Those without personal saving faith in Jesus Christ are to refrain from the Sacrament and are urged to repent and receive Him by faith. *\*The bread is gluten free.*
