September/October, 2021

In September, we were blessed to be able to have a part in a special 5-day tent meeting with Wayne and Sue Fair in the village of Kaware. Pastor Leslee Daniels from Bible Truth Baptist Church in Mount Hagen was the main speaker for most of the night services, while bro Wayne Fair and I taught morning sessions. Sheila and Betty Daniels (Pastor Leslee's wife) also each had a chance to speak to the ladies during some morning sessions. **During this meeting, we were blessed to see 28 people call upon the Lord to save them and saw many Christians stirred up!!**

After the meeting, we began a month-long battle with various sicknesses. We have learned that whenever God is moving in a mighty way, the Devil will always try to come and discourage or distract. Bro Wayne and Sue came down sick and were pretty much "bed-ridden" for a few weeks. Sheila worked to keep them supplied with soup, and I was able to go to the store and pharmacy for them. Praise the Lord that they are now doing much better, but as soon as their sickness was finishing, our children contracted chicken pox somehow. After 2 weeks of itchiness and fevers, we are finally coming out of the chicken pox woods!!

In October, I was blessed to start teaching classes for the Nebilyer Baptist Bible School in the Nebilyer Valley. I have been teaching a Rightly Dividing class on Monday mornings, and a Prophecy class on Tuesday mornings, and have been greatly encouraged by how well these students have been grasping this material.

Three pastors started this small Bible Institute earlier this year before we arrived, and there are currently about 17 students coming to school. Some of these students are pastors and their wives, others are preachers who are working in new church plants in the area, and others are brand new Christians who are just anxious to learn more of God's word. As I mentioned in my last letter, I have been asked to take the leadership of this school starting next year, and we all are praying together for the Lord to give his direction in this matter. This seems like a great open door, but we ask you to pray about this matter with us in the coming weeks.

I was also asked to help out at a new church plant(Resurrection Baptist Church) just outside of town in Keltiga by covering every Wednesday night service. On Sundays, preachers and pastors from Nebilyer rotate covering the services, but Wednesdays is more difficult for them due to the lack of public transportation in the evenings.

Please pray for these various ministries and churches in Nebilyer and Keltiga as we have seen much fruit lately. We have seen about 15 people saved in the last three weeks or so in both the Nebilyer Churches and Keltiga, as well as many Christians stirred up to be more involved in church and outreach. 2 of these new converts have even enrolled in Bible School!!

Lastly, we greatly appreciate your prayers for our family. We have been in PNG for 7 months now, and God has been so good to help us with this transition. We are so thankful that everyone has adjusted well to life here and has settled into a routine of homeschool and ministry. After our crazy schedule on deputation for 2 years, it is such a blessing to get back into somewhat of a "normal" routine of life again!!
