

Keep shining your light and love!







Faith Promise 2022: "Love Lights the Way"

Faith Promise is one of the primary ways our church supports both local and international missions.


While Faith Promise donations can take different forms (see box to the right), a primary way is to ask the Lord how much they should give to missions over the next year—and then commit to that amount as a "Faith Promise," asking God to provide the funds. Faith

Faith Promise Sources:

- **1. Money Unusually Attained!** A pay raise, promotion, bonus, overtime pay, a hobby, an inheritance, a gift.
- **2. Money Deliberately Retained!** Changed priorities, denying a luxury, delaying a purchase, fasting a meal.
- **3. Money Surprisingly Regained!** Tax refund, investment return, repaid debt, coupons, rebates, refunds.
- **4. Money Intentionally Maintained!** Commitment to regular giving, trusting God to supply.

Promise thus makes missions giving strategic rather than sporadic. It is faith-based; that is, it is not primarily a personal budget item but a way to partner with the Lord, trusting Him to provide the funds that have been "promised."
