

Have you signed up (joined) our Faithful Church Group yet? Currently we have 90 who have! This is such a wonderful ministry tool we have access to now. For those who have, I pray you are finding how great this resource is! For those who have not yet, **I pray you will today!** On your computer, go to faithlife.com and click the "Register" button at the top right. You put in your email and password (WRITE THIS DOWN SO WON'T LOSE IT!), then search in the search box for Hollins Road Baptist Church. Select it and finish. Then one of our admins will get your request and accept your request to join our church group. Once in you can browse around and see all the features. It is similar to Facebook but I like it far more! You can set up to do online giving if you desire. You can check on our Urgent Prayer Needs link. You can click on the link to Faithlife TV where you can watch over 1000 different Christian based movies and documentaries. If you chose to use your smartphone instead of your computer to join, go to your phone's app store and download "Faithlife: Community for Churches." Then you sign up for a new account...and follow the same process listed above for the computer.


This new ministry resource is helping us stay in better touch with each other and communicate important things. One powerful feature, is the ability for Teams and Groups to communicate and work together better. Another powerful feature, is the ability to access Logos, a Bible based resource to help you study God's Word. Soon we will hold a class one evening for any who would like to learn how to use this resource. So be watching for this class.

Another exciting and very important feature is the Church Management part of this resource. Once you REGISTER to sign up for Faithlife and then join our Group (Hollins Road Baptist), you can enter your own personal information (address, home phone, mobile phone, email address, family connections, spiritual gifts, etc.). This will help us have your most up-to-date information. And if your address or email or mobile phone number changes, you can update it yourself! We HOPE you will! Pretty cool! And you can add a photo of your choice for our digital directory... and you can change it as often as you choose!

This is important: On your My Faithlife page the upper left side panel, you see Settings. Click there and it will take you to the page where you can set **your Profile** (your address, mobile phone, etc.) and **Notifications** (how you want to be notified and when). Make sure when you set up your Profile that you check the box by your mobile phone that it is okay to text you (we will use this for urgent push notifications). And make sure you check the box saying it is okay to publish you in our directory (only our Faithlife group members can see this information).

Again, **our goal is to get everyone who has a computer and smartphone to REGISTER/JOIN Faithlife and join our Church Group.** This will get you more connected with all that is going on, build our community together, encourage you in your faith and help you to grow in your walk with the Lord! It may be a little overwhelming at first, but once you get REGISTERED and joined in our Church Group and community, you will see that it is really not too difficult. And you will see how powerful and beneficial this tool is!
