

Children's Pastor Job Description

Desired Qualifications:

Candidates for this position must have made a personal commitment to Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and must demonstrate this relationship through their life and testimony. Preference of joining as member of Greer Church of God of Prophecy for this position.

Overview:

Part-time position to develop and maintain strategies that will allow Greer Church of God of Prophecy to minister to children in a way that glorifies God, the Father, the Son, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit. Provide a well—balanced program that will seek to win the lost to Christ and to help those who are Christians to mature in Christ and desire to discover the personal gifts and abilities with which God has blessed them. Children by definition include ages 5 to 11.

Duties:

- Establish annual goals, objectives and plans to implement the children's ministry strategies.
- Develop a yearly budget of expected needs for the children's ministries and submit to Finance and Administrative Committee.
- Plan and oversee all children's ministries activities and programs including with a primary focus on Sunday morning and Wednesday night children's services. This applies to all special events including Vacation Bible School. (A separate VBS Director may be appointed).
- Research resources and make recommendations for developing the children's ministries programming.
- As possible, pursue and participate in continuing education events and training opportunities within children's ministries practices.
- Establish a friendly rapport with and among the children through a variety of fun, and purposeful activities.
- Develop and promote biblically-based education through Bible studies and other programs.
- Encourage the children to get involved in special projects. Seek to provide them frequent opportunities to do so.
- Provide spiritual guidance to the children and their parents as needed.
- Provide hospital visitation of children or parent as needed.
- Recruit, train and oversee volunteer children's ministries staff. Make sure that all volunteers submit proper paperwork for background checks before their initial work with the children.
- Maintain open communication with church staff, parents and members of the congregation. Seek to
 integrate children's ministries into all phases of church life to assist in creating a culture that is
 intentionally intergenerational, striving to unite with and complement other church ministries.
- Oversee fund-raising efforts for children's ministries needs.
- As possible, attend scheduled staff meetings.





Requirements:

- Must be a born again believer in Jesus Christ.
- Must be a good Christian role model. References may be requested later in the selection process.
- Must be willing to undergo a mandatory background investigation.
- Regular and reliable attendance in worship services and in performance of job.
- Shall perform the duties of his/her position under the supervision/leadership of the Lead Pastor.
- Submit quarterly report to Lead Pastor
