Memorize

Psalm 46:1-3 God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling.

- **Review**
 - **Ephesians 6:11,17-18** Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil ... And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication.
 - **Ephesians 4:32** Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.
 - the answer to **Question 265 – *What is God's will for my life?*** (Explanation page 256)
 - the answer to the question: ***How does God's kingdom come?*** (Explanation page 246)
 - The answer to **Question 270 – *What do we mean by "daily bread"?***
 - **Psalm 145:15-16** The eyes of all look to You, and You give them their food in due season. You open your hand; You satisfy the desire of every living thing.
