** Responsible for all properties owned by the local church. Responsibilities include oversight and participation in the care and maintenance of existing properties, planning for future capital projects and property ownership or sale. In addition, participate in outreach opportunities to the society and community with property care assistance.

Treasurer (1 Treasurer and 1 Assistant Treasurer)

** Responsible for the recording of all monies raised and the manner in which they are expended. Processes payments of bills and other expenditures. Prepares a monthly report to the BOA, and a full report to the Annual Society Meeting. Works with the Pastors and financial team in the preparation and monitoring of the VBC budget.

Christian Education Ministry Leader (1 person)

Nominee: _

** Creates a CE Team responsible for the Spiritual growth of the congregation. Oversees this team which includes adult, teen, and children's ministry leaders. Works with the team to recruit, train, and monitor CE ministry leaders and teachers. Areas included are Children's and Adult Sunday School, Children's Church, Connection Groups, Youth Group, VBS, and related training seminars. Makes budgetary recommendations to meet the vision and needs of the respective CE areas.

** Works with the Pastors to review all ministry leader nominations based on Christian maturity, faithfulness to the local body, Spiritual gifts, and abilities. Prepares a nomination's list for the Annual Meeting of the Society.
