The program is designed to give participants a deeper understanding both of Passover and of the Communion table.

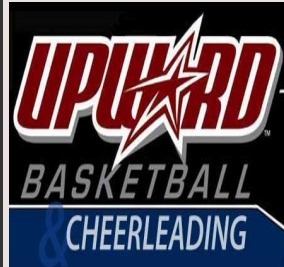
