# **Special Announcement re: BSA**

**District Church Conferences:** Additionally, we've been asked by our District leadership to inform everyone about upcoming District-wide Church Conferences where church members are invited to contribute to upcoming decisions regarding our denominations affiliation with the Boy Scouts of America. You may have heard that BSA in recent years has faced lawsuits and bankruptcy, resulting in potential legal liabilities for chartering organizations, including our United Methodist Churches. Conference leadership has been in ongoing discussions to find the best way for local churches to be able to support the important work of Boy Scouts while avoiding further difficulties in the ongoing pending and lawsuits. At these district-wide church conferences, representatives from each congregation will give their votes to help determine the future of this situation. There are three options for you to attend: Saturday, December 4<sup>th</sup> at 1030am at Wesley UMC in Selinsgrove at1030am, or at 2pm at St. Andrew's UMC in Milton, or Sunday, December 5<sup>th</sup> at 2pm at Wesley UMC in Nescopeck.
