

DB's Dabblings: "What's Happening in December"

Let's start with Wednesday nights. After Wednesday night Dec. 1, we have one more Bible class on the names of God, Dec. 8, "The God Who Sees," this semester. If you have not been coming to these classes, I encourage you to come. You will enjoy and benefit from it; and you will want to start going on a regular basis in the new year. If you want to join us for dinner, it is served at 5:30 in the Family Center. We all start together in class at 6:30 in the auditorium (except the teens who are in the Family Center for REVIVE) to introduce the name of God we are studying that evening. At 6:45, the children and their parents go to the Family Bible Class and the 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grades go to their class; and the adults left meet with me in the back of the auditorium for a little deeper dive into the study of God's name. Then we divide into the men's and women's small groups to discuss it. You will leave with a deeper understanding of the nature of God and the opportunity to grow with your church family in applying it in practical ways to your Christian walk. The class will start back next semester on Wednesday night, Jan. 5. The reason we are not having class Wednesday night, Dec. 15 is we need as many volunteers to help with the Community Christmas Dinner as possible. Then we will not meet the Wednesday nights during the Christmas break, Dec. 22 and Dec. 29.

Sunday mornings during December I will be doing a series of sermons on "Birth Announcements." I will be preaching on the biblical announcements related to the birth of Jesus. But not Dec. 12, Wes will be preaching and the day will involve several opportunities for the Youth and Family Ministry related to the Christmas holiday including the Youth Ministry and Children's Ministry parties. We will not have classes the Sunday morning after Christmas, Dec. 26, only the worship service at 10:00.

Also during December, we will be getting ready for 2022. This will involve working on our renovation plans, including the auditorium, the education wing, technology improvements, and security. We will be praying for the new year and our effectiveness in our Kingdom mission here at the Graham Street Church. We will be working on plans for all our ministries to be better rooted in Christ and the Word, for greater growth in becoming Christlike as disciples and as a church family, and to increase our outreach into our community and the world.






## "Family Connection"


2nd Sunday Emphasis Recommitting to Small Groups Your Family Connection To Our Church Family Starting September Some Family Discussion Questions:
