*	Those who walk in the light are to be marked by This love is shown in obedience to God (John 15:10; 1 John 2:3) and in loving others (John 15:12, 17; 1 John 4:7–8). Love for others is a sign of God's in the life of a believer (John 13:34–35; 1 John 4:7–12).				
*	Since God is love, anyone who does not love others shows that God is in him (1 John 4:20). Loving others is not a suggestion for believers; it is a (Mark 12:30–31). Jesus told His (John 13:34). *	Our love for is another way the world can see God. Because of God's love for us (John 3:16; 1 John 4:9), He sent His Son into the world that we might live through Him both in this life and for eternity.
