### TEXT

#### **Titus 2:9-15** *ESV*

<sup>9</sup> Bondservants are to be submissive to their own masters in every-thing; they are to be well-pleasing, not argumentative, <sup>10</sup> not pilfering, but showing all good faith, so that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior.

<sup>11</sup> For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, <sup>12</sup> training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, <sup>13</sup> waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, <sup>14</sup> who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

<sup>15</sup> Declare these things; exhort and rebuke with all authority. Let no one disregard you.

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## **Journey Group Questions**

- 1. Talk about the saying "Yes, there's grace; but we should live like there isn't any."
  - a. How do you see this attitude in your own heart and walk with God?
  - b. How does Titus 2:11-14 counteract this attitude? How do these verses reframe our perspective?
- **2.** It's often uncomfortable for us to talk about the Bible verses that address slavery. Why is this? How do these verses (2:9-10) help us grow as disciples? How do these verses help us see the radical importance of Christ's first & second comings?
- **3.** In what ways does Grace "teach" us? How does grace shape and change how we interact with ourselves? With others? With God?
- 4. How can you and I look forward to Christ's coming again?
- 5. How can we as a church create an environment and atmosphere of grace?
