DB's Dabblings: "Getting Ready For A New Year"

I spent much of 2021 preaching on "Going Back Better Than Normal" using principles of "Teamwork" from the book of Nehemiah and applying them to what we should do as a church to not just go back to normal but do better than normal. Although we have already started applying these principles to our planning and ministries, 2022 offers a new opportunity to put these principles into specific function in our church efforts to bring glory to God. Let's review these principles and put some concrete plans and strategies with them.

- 1. Commit to shared goals and work on them together in prayer.
- 2. Through Prayer, believe God will give success as we work together to His Glory.
- 3. Work together dividing up the work involving the whole church.
- 4. Every member gives full-hearted commitment to the work.
- 5. Protect, support, and encourage each other as we work together.
- 6. With every success give glory to God and celebrate in worship.
- 7. Recommit ourselves to the Word of God and Prayer.

Principle 1: Commit to shared goals and work on them together in prayer.

We have been able to review our ministries in 2021 and we understand some vital areas we need to improve and emphasize as we go forward, for example:

- 1). Recommit as a whole church to our vision of being Rooted, Growing and Reaching. Rooted in the Word of God (Scripture and Christ), Growing to Be Christlike, Reaching Up to God and Out to others through love and service.
- 2). Take care of the physical, emotional, spiritual needs of the church family.
- **3). Improve our infrastructure for ministry,** including renovating our facilities and improving our technology, organization, and administration.



#### **Some Family Discussion Questions:**


- 1. Who outside our family do we know in the church? How could we make that a stronger connection?
