DB's Dabblings: "Getting Ready For A New Year" (continued from last week)

Let's continue to look for specific ways we can continue to **"go back better" in 2022**. Here is the list of principles we committed to as we work on our mission to be **Rooted, Growing and Reaching in the New Year.** 

- 1. Commit to shared goals and work on them together in prayer.
- 2. Through Prayer, believe God will give success as we work together to His Glory.
- 3. Work together dividing up the work involving the whole church.
- 4. Every member gives full-hearted commitment to the work.
- 5. Protect, support, and encourage each other as we work together.
- 6. With every success give glory to God and celebrate in worship.
- 7. Recommit ourselves to the Word of God and Prayer.

Let's connect all seven together using the Youth and Family Ministry as an example of where we are coming into the new year. Wes announced last Sunday that he is starting a new work at the Lake Jackson Church of Christ. (You can read Wes' announcement on page 9.) We of course pray for him and Nichole to have a great ministry there, and great opportunities for Bria and Beckett in their new community. At the same time, we are sad to see them leave, and it has left us with several holes to fill. This gives a perfect illustration of the opportunity to apply all 7 Principles above. As we move forward in the process of preparing ourselves for the minister that will join us in this work, we must pull together in a commitment to all 7. Here are some things we need to do that applies specifically to Youth and Family Ministry, but really they apply to everything we are trying to do at Graham Street Church of Christ.

- 1. We need to review and better understand the Youth and Family Ministry and set goals in prayer for that ministry and its connection to every ministry of the church that relates to it. We need to understand how this relates to the responsibility of the Minister working in this ministry and make this a part of our search process.
- 2. We need to commit to a season of prayer believing that God will give us success in finding the right person to work with us to the Glory of God.
- 3. We need to work together as a whole church in this process with the understanding that we can all contribute something to the success of our mission.
- 4. We must all be fully committed with a heartfelt desire to fully support the efforts in this ministry, even when a different approach or methodology was chosen than what we suggested.

- 5. Every member must be committed to support and encourage one another, and protect each other from Satan's efforts to divide us and defeat us in our efforts. We must support the new minister and his family and everyone working in this ministry. We cannot tolerate negative destructive discourse, gossiping, slander, backbiting, etc. We are in this together and God will give us success, unless we let Satan divide us and cause us to focus on ourselves instead of the goal of developing a "Rooted, Growing, and Reaching" Youth and Family Ministry.
- 6. We must never lose sight of our mission to bring glory to God through our Youth and Family Ministry. We will celebrate our success giving God the glory in worship and praise to Him!
- 7. We must remember our commitment to the Word and Prayer throughout this process and beyond. Our basic fundamental mission of discipleship summed up in the 3 words:

  "Rooted, Growing, Reaching," is a reminder of who we are and what we are about. This is what we want for our children and teens, and their parents, and the whole church. We are rooted as the disciples of Christ in the Word of God (Scripture and Christ) through prayer; we are growing to be like Christ in all we do and say; and we are reaching upward to God in worship, outward to impact the world for Christ, and inward to our church family to help every member in all age groups to be Rooted, Growing and Reaching.







#### Statement from Wes on December 19, 2021

Dear Church Family,

On December 12, I was privileged and blessed to share with you in a sermon, the idea that God's story is "To Be Continued" through us. I hope we all understand that God has huge expectations of us, but he expects those things because he knows we can fulfill them. I pray that you will not overlook the urgency to re-prioritize your lives, to live your life in a way unlike never before, so that to tell your story is to tell of him.

In January, my family's story will be continued. We will say goodbye to Stephenville being our home, but the Graham Street Church of Christ will always be part of who we are.

It is with both sorrow and excitement that we announce that we will be moving to Lake Jackson, Texas to begin serving with the Lake Jackson Church of Christ.

We are saddened because we will miss the friendships and relationships that we have formed here, for the community that we've been surrounded by. Distance does not mean the end of friendships and relationships, but rather the strengthening of both.

We are excited because we know that God IS CONTINUING and WILL CONTINUE to do amazing things at the Graham Street Church. I encourage you, don't just support the Graham Street Church, be invested it, be involved in it. Look for future opportunities to grow and change who you are... not for your benefit, but for the benefit of others. To share this quote again from my cousin, "You don't treat someone a certain way because of who they are. You treat someone a certain way because of who you are."

It was not an easy decision for us to go, but we have been praying for God to make it evident to us; and despite our best efforts to ignore God's signs, we have accepted that our plan and timing may not have been perfectly in sync with God's.

So we are taking a leap of faith, for our story to be continued, in order to follow God's plan for our lives.

Our time here has not been perfect or easy, but it has been a blessing and growing experience for my family. We know that God has been preparing us for this move. Our time and service here has been preparing us for our future service in ministry. We thank you for molding us into who we are today.

Thank you to those of you who welcomed us, loved us, and accepted us as part of your family. We have cherished the privilege to be a part of your children's lives.

We will appreciate all of your prayers as we continue our journey elsewhere. Each of you will be in our prayers, even from afar. We look forward to sharing these final weeks with you.

Thank you for being our family, for letting this be home. May God strengthen you and your service in this community in the years to come. We love you.
