Week 1: He Gives Good Gifts

This first week we want to hit on the fact that God has given us all good gifts. We are called to use these gifts to honor Him and strengthen the church. These are not for our own glory and pride. With this first week, let's lay a foundation of using these gifts with an attitude that pleases God.

PRAYER TIME

THIS IS YOUR DAILY SCRIPTURE:

Pursue love and desire spiritual gifts, and especially that you may prophesy (1 Cor. 14:1).

THIS IS YOUR DAILY PRAYER:

Lord, I desire spiritual gifts from You. I know You have given to me what pleases You. Lord, may You give me a gift that I may encourage and strengthen my family and the church You have me at.

DRIVE TIME

CONVERSATION

PARENT PRE-READING: *Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God (1 Peter 4:10).*

CONVERSATION STARTER: I was reading in 1 Peter 4:10, and it talks about how we should be good stewards of the gifts that God has given us. What do you think it would look like to be bad stewards of the gifts He gives?

STARTING QUESTIONS

Do you think God wants us to be generous with what we have? Why or why not?

READ THIS TOGETHER For by the grace given to me, I tell everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he should think. Instead, think sensibly, as God has distributed a measure of faith to each one. Now as we have many parts in one body, and all the parts do not have the same function, in the same way we who are many are one body in Christ and individually members of one another (Rom. 12: 3-5).

How might it build our own faith that God will take care of our needs by giving to others?

How do we make sure that we are giving out of obedience and a love for others and not just as selfish gain for ourselves?
