Week 3: Don't Neglect Your Gift

PRAYER TIME

THIS IS YOUR DAILY SCRIPTURE:

Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, who does not change like shifting shadows (James 1:17).

THIS IS YOUR DAILY PRAYER:

God, every good and perfect gift is from You. Help me always remember this truth and be reminded that You do not change.

DRIVE TIME

CONVERSATION

PARENT PRE-READING: *Don't neglect the gift that is in you; it was given to you through prophecy, with the laying on of hands by the council of elders (1 Tim. 4:14).*

CONVERSATION STARTER: In 1 Timothy, Paul reminds Timothy not to neglect the gift that God had given him. What are some ways that someone might neglect a gift that God gives them?

Tell me about a time when you had a good leader? What was this experience like? Who was it and what made them a great leader?

What are we saying to God when we don't like the job or gift that He seems to have given us?
