## CONVERSATION

### STARTING QUESTIONS

**READ THIS TOGETHER** According to the grace given to us, we have different gifts: If prophecy, use it according to the proportion of one's faith; if service, use it in service; if teaching, in teaching; if exhorting, in exhortation; giving, with generosity; leading, with diligence; showing mercy, with cheerfulness (Rom. 12:6-8).

### SCRIPTURAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS

After each gift in these verses, there seems to be an attitude attached. Why do you think Scripture would talk about not just giving, but with generosity, or not just leading, but with diligence?

With the gift that you believe God has given you, what attitude do you think He would desire you to have as you use your gift?
