



### Statement from Wes on December 19, 2021

Dear Church Family,

On December 12, I was privileged and blessed to share with you in a sermon, the idea that God's story is "To Be Continued" through us. I hope we all understand that God has huge expectations of us, but he expects those things because he knows we can fulfill them. I pray that you will not overlook the urgency to re-prioritize your lives, to live your life in a way unlike never before, so that to tell your story is to tell of him.

In January, my family's story will be continued. We will say goodbye to Stephenville being our home, but the Graham Street Church of Christ will always be part of who we are.

It is with both sorrow and excitement that we announce that we will be moving to Lake Jackson, Texas to begin serving with the Lake Jackson Church of Christ.

We are saddened because we will miss the friendships and relationships that we have formed here, for the community that we've been surrounded by. Distance does not mean the end of friendships and relationships, but rather the strengthening of both.

We are excited because we know that God IS CONTINUING and WILL CONTINUE to do amazing things at the Graham Street Church. I encourage you, don't just support the Graham Street Church, be invested it, be involved in it. Look for future opportunities to grow and change who you are... not for your benefit, but for the benefit of others. To share this quote again from my cousin, "You don't treat someone a certain way because of who they are. You treat someone a certain way because of who you are."

It was not an easy decision for us to go, but we have been praying for God to make it evident to us; and despite our best efforts to ignore God's signs, we have accepted that our plan and timing may not have been perfectly in sync with God's.

So we are taking a leap of faith, for our story to be continued, in order to follow God's plan for our lives.

Our time here has not been perfect or easy, but it has been a blessing and growing experience for my family. We know that God has been preparing us for this move. Our time and service here has been preparing us for our future service in ministry. We thank you for molding us into who we are today.

Thank you to those of you who welcomed us, loved us, and accepted us as part of your family. We have cherished the privilege to be a part of your children's lives.

We will appreciate all of your prayers as we continue our journey elsewhere. Each of you will be in our prayers, even from afar. We look forward to sharing these final weeks with you.

Thank you for being our family, for letting this be home. May God strengthen you and your service in this community in the years to come. We love you.
