DB's Dabblings: "Better Understanding What We Need To Do Better"

We have been encouraging one another to "Be Better Than Normal" this year. But in order to do that we need to evaluate what we need to do better. This is especially true now that we are needing to engage in a Youth and Family Minister Search. To do this we need to identify the areas where we need to improve, and it would help to have a neutral perspective. Churches, like individuals, tend to see themselves from built-in biases and with incentives to look at themselves in a more favorable view than reality. The Siburt Institute for Church Growth has developed the Church Health Assessment (CHA) to help churches have an honest and fair evaluation tool into some of the most basic areas that influence the health of the church. Although other similar tools exist for congregational assessment, this is the only tool available today that is tested for reliability and specifically designed for Churches of Christ. It takes the guesswork out of measuring congregational attitudes and perspectives. The CHA measures the following key factors:

- 1. Vision, mission, and goals
- 2. Ministry and activity effectiveness
- 3. Family life stages
- 4. Spiritual formation and discipleship
- 5. Worship
- 6. Congregational culture, communication, and conflict
- 7. Leadership
- 8. Church relationships
- 9. Finance and facilities

The instrument gathers numerical ratings and open-ended comments from participants, and summarizes member involvement and demographics. Its online platform makes it reasonably priced and simple to administer, and the report for church leaders is user-friendly.

The Elders are asking the church to take this online assessment beginning January 23 through January 30. It generally takes only 15 minutes to respond to this questionnaire. It will be evaluated by Siburt Institute and returned to us. The Elders have asked Grady King to go over the results with us after the results are tabulated. This will probably take place in mid-February. We feel we need to take this evaluation of ourselves before we start our Youth and Family Minister Search.

Also, you are invited to be a part of the discussion of the "Youth and Family Ministry" in the GPS (Godly Parenting Skills) Class on Sunday Mornings at 9:00. We will talk about such subjects as defining the ministry and its mission. What should be the expectations of the minister? How engaged should the parents be in the ministry? What is expected of the students? What should be the mix of teaching and activities? How do you build the unity of the group? And more...




2nd Sunday Emphasis Recommitting to Small Groups Your Family Connection To Our Church Family Starting September Some Family Discussion Questions:
