

-About Korean Traditional Instruments

Gayageum: Gayageum is a traditional Korean 12- stringed instrument, which has been around for almost 1,000 years. It is one of the most beloved instruments both among Koreans and throughout the world. There are various types, such as 18- stringed and 25- stringed. The Gayageum played today is the 12- stringed "Sanjo Gayageum"

Janggu: Janggu is a type of percussion in Korea. The Korean Janggu usually serves as accompaniment. However, nowadays, a genre called "Samullori" has been played using the Jaggu and other percussion instruments.

^{*}Arirang is the most famous folk song in Korea. There are hundreds of forms with lyrics changing across different local dialects. Arirang expresses the longing felt by those who are missing and waiting for a dear one who has gone. Some Christian denominations in the US use the tune of Arirang in hymns.
