Important Note Regarding the Little Free Pantry:

Canned goods, as well as various edible or potable liquids, can freeze in cold weather. This can be a food safety hazard and may make people ill under certain conditions. Therefore, we strongly urge food donors to give canned goods, store bought jarred sauces, and the like directly to the Canton Food Bank during cold weather months, and to limit donations in the LFP to items which will remain

safe to consume after freezing (dry goods and things like that). The simplest way to donate to the Canton Food Bank directly is to bring your donations to church on the third Sunday of each month, when we take up a food offering in baskets on the Platform. Thank you very much for your generosity!
