Let's read 1 Samuel 21:1-9... how does the beginning scene fit into Jesus' visit to the synagogue at the end of this episode? What point does this make about the importance of knowing the Old Testament to better appreciate the New Testament?

Peter and Matthew are sent to look for Mar. While we don't know that this event took place, do you think Jesus might have put together two disciples to grow or stretch them in their faith and in working together? Is it possible that some of the people you meet are ways in which the Lord is growing you?

In Jesus' mother, Mary's conversation with Remah, she encourages her to do what in light of her fears and concerns? Have you ever felt like Remah? How hard is it to put your trust in the Lord in those situations? In the bar scene, Mary seems at times to be struggling with her actions, what prevents her from overcoming? What do you think of Jesus' handling of Mary's return? How might that scene be helpful to many?

What lessons do we learn about the disciples in the conversation between Andrew and Thomas? John and James?

What do we learn about the challenge of the keeping of the law in Jesus' day? Do you see similar legalism today? How does Jesus challenge the situation?
