


### God lives in me!

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There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.


And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.





### Obsolete regulations

  - Ceremonial laws Heb 9:13

- "It's all good"! Only getting better!!





### A Temporary glow

#### Exodus 34

When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the covenant law in his hands, he was not aware that his face was radiant because he had spoken with the LORD. When Aaron and all the Israelites saw Moses, his face was radiant, and they were afraid to come near him...

When Moses finished speaking to them, he put a veil over his face. But whenever he entered the LORD's presence to speak with him, he removed the veil until he came out.











### Day of Atonement

The Day of Atonement was the most solemn of all days in Israel. This was the day of National and Sanctuary Cleansing.

Atonement means- kaphar -kaw-fart to cover (specifically with bitumen); figuratively to expiate or condone, to placate or cancel: - appease, make (an) atonement, cleanse, disannul, forgive, be merciful, pacify, pardon, to pitch, purge (away), put off, (make) reconcile (-liation).
