It is a 160-bed homeless rehabilitation program, which has four distinct shelters for four populations: men, women, women with children, and veterans. We provide food, clothing, shelter, counseling, case management, medical interventions and referrals, mental health stabilization and legal assistance, as well as a life-transforming recovery program which includes: Addiction Recovery, Anger Management, Relapse Prevention, Parenting, Trauma Recovery, Budgeting, Job Training, Work Readiness, Career Assessments, and Vocational Classes.

### Session Meeting Highlights January 17, 2022

**Future Focus:** We discussed the implications of what we notice to be true about the people and resources God has provided us with.

- With members predominantly over the age of 60, we need to be thinking about their particular needs for care, spiritual formation, accessibility, service, and participation.
- With approximately 300 CLC users on our campus each week, we have an opportunity to consider how we might connect with them, potentially offering such things as support or study groups and opportunities for mission.
- With new neighborhoods being built all around us, we need to consider how to prepare to connect with them. It was noted that the funds from the capital campaign designated for spiritual formation/mission provide an opportunity to experiment in living in to the realities listed above. We discussed forming a task force to discern how we might focus our work

### over the next year. We will begin by having session members give the items above some additional thought and encourage their committees to do the same. Next month, we will continue the conversation.

### **COVID Task Force**

• Given recent member input regarding the increased risk posed by the omicron variant, the task force will revisit the COVID protocols.

#### Mission Outreach and Service Team

Washington Presbytery

- Advised Session 40% of Pentecost collection be designated for Go Time Ministries.
- Advised Session 25% of the Peace & Global Witness collection to be designated for Heifer International.
- Voted to place a Special Olympics clothing /shoe collection box near the dumpsters on a trial basis.

#### **Buildings and Grounds**

- Approved up to \$9,000.00 to replace furnace in CLC to heat the entry way, bathrooms, and kitchen.
- Asked each committee to prepare a list of maintenance items and potential capital projects for discussion at their next meeting.
