Aloha Church,

As we continue into 2022, we look forward to many different events. Some of these focus on within in training and discipleship. Others look outward to bless those in our community. In all of these events, we see a powerful opportunity to share the love of God with others. One of the greatest expressions of our love for God is to worship Him well. The fact that we can draw near to communion with our creator through the work of Christ by the guidance of the Holy Spirit is an amazing gift.

I am reminded of God's love and everything we have not because of our work but by His grace. Every time we gather in worship, we experience the results of God's grace in the work of Christ. In Christ, we are cleansed, and we have full assurance not in our acts but in our faith. This work of Jesus is a true expression of God's love. We are saved through this work because God loved us before we could love Him.

Throughout the time of the Old Testament, worship had physical requirements. Specific acts had to be performed by specific people in specific places. Through all the worship rituals, the divide of sin could not be overcome. But now we know that this was a shadow of heavenly worship. We can enter the Holy of Holies through the sacrifice of Christ. Jesus himself tells the woman at the well that worship will no longer take place on the mountain, but in him, we worship God in spirit and truth. We gather in our building not because it is sacred, but instead, it becomes sacred when God calls us together to worship and glorify His name.

Throughout the coming months, we have the opportunity to show God's love. We can express this in our worship, discipleship, and outreach. In everything that we do, let us stir one another up to good works to show the love of God to the world. May we seek to worship well but build one another up to go out and share this amazing love of God with all of the lost around us.
