

Camp Covenant Information Sheet 2022

Camp Covenant is for children entering grades 1 –3 for the 2022 -2023 School Year. As campers explore different topics throughout the summer, they will be encouraged to:

- take good care of themselves, our earth, and each other
- learn new things
- express their creativity
- be kind and have fun

There are 8 weeks of exploration, with campers attending 2 days a week (Tuesday and Thursday) from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm. Campers take a deep dive into the topics on Tuesday with hands on activities, discussions, short lessons and presentations, and arts and crafts. On Thursday children continue exploration of the topics with a local field trip and a picnic lunch in the middle of the day. Campers may sign up for individual weeks, or for the whole summer.

The cost listed in the chart below includes the application fee, supplies, and field trips.

* Parents must also provide a packed morning snack, lunch, and afternoon snack for their child every day.

Schedule: Camp meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm.

Group Size and Child/Teacher Ratios: Enrollment is limited to no more than 12 children per group. There will be at least 2 teachers with the group.

Staff: Our staff members are experienced and caring. All staff members have BCI and FBI background checks, and at least 10 hours of training in child development and/or health and safety every year. There is always at least one staff member on site during program hours who is certified in first aid, CPR, management of communicable diseases, and recognizing signs of child abuse.

Transportation: Children will be transported for field trips on the Covenant Children’s Center bus. Parents must sign a permission slip giving children permission to ride on the bus.
