DAY 5 Read John 15:16-17 & 17:20-21 focusing on Jesus Choosing You.

What does Jesus tell you about his choice here? What is He telling you right now? What is Jesus' prayer for you specifically right now form this? How is that working out for you? From all of this, I Have Decided to _____. Pray and then Go do it.

4 Core Elements of Jesus' Dream Team

1. Jesus is interceding on your behalf.

"One day soon afterward Jesus went up on a mountain to pray, and he prayed to God all night."

2. Jesus is inviting you to join His team on His mission.

3. Jesus is installing His gifts in you for His purpose.

"...and chose twelve of them to be apostles. Here are their names: Simon (whom he named Peter), Andrew (Peter's brother), James, John, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James (son of Alphaeus), Simon (who was called the zealot), Judas (son of James), Judas Iscariot (who later betrayed him)."

DAY 1 Read Luke 6:12-16 focusing on Jesus Praying All Night.

Describe as best you can the context of Jesus praying – what has happened before and after? What could Jesus be praying about ALL night and what does that mean to you and for you? How does it help to know that Jesus is "interceding" for you right now? (Rom.8:34; Heb.7:25) What is He praying for you? Spend extra time in prayer today with Jesus.

DAY 2 Read Luke 6:12-16 focusing on Who Jesus DID NOT Choose.

Who are all the "disciples/followers" of Jesus that aren't chosen as one of the 12 Apostles? (Can you name any of them?) If you were in the group and Jesus starting calling names, what would you be thinking about being chosen or not chosen? How is your attitude now about where Jesus has you and what He has chosen you to do or not do? Pray for His direction and being present right where He has you.

DAY 3 Read Luke 6:12-16 focusing on Who Jesus DID Choose.

What can you tell about these 12 guys – similarities & differences? What do you think Jesus saw in them, if anything, that caused him to choose them? How does John 15:16 connect with this? What would be the main differences between what they would do and what the rest of the disciples of Jesus would do? Why did Jesus choose you and for what purpose? Pray.
