DAY 4 Read Luke 7:11-17 focusing on the Widow of Nain's Pain.

What do you know about this widow before Jesus shows up? What do you learn about Jesus here by what He says & does? If you were in the funeral procession that day, what's your take on what happened? What's the "aha moment" for the crowd (1Kings 17:17-24) When was your last "aha moment" with Jesus? Pray for "A Holy Awareness" of God's presence in your life.

DAY 5 Read Luke 7:18-23 focusing on John's Faith in Jesus.

The two previous situations are connected to John the Baptist's big question. What was his question and what does this show you about John's faith? How does this connect to you and your faith in Jesus? What does Jesus tell John's disciples and what do you think John's response was? When your faith gets shaken a little or a lot, what's your typical response, questions, and answers? Pray for your faith to be encouraging to others around you.

DAY 1 Read Luke 7:1-5 focusing on the Roman Centurion's Situation. What can you tell about this Roman Centurion from this? Why does he send respected Jewish elders and what's their take on this guy? How would you describe the Centurion's faith in Jesus at this point? Who are you praying specifically for that God would do something great to increase their faith in Him personally? Pray for them today and God using you in the situation.

DAY 2 Read Luke 7:6-8 focusing on the Roman Centurion's Aha Moment. What do you think Jesus thought when the friends came and said, "Lord, don't trouble yourself...I'm not worthy." What did this Soldier know about authority that translated into total faith in Jesus' word? What can you learn about faith in Jesus from this Roman Centurion? How's your relationship to the Word right now and giving it absolute authority in your life? Explain. Pray for greater trust & obedience to the Word.

DAY 3 Read Luke 7:9-10 focusing on Jesus' Response.

What do you think it means that Jesus was amazed by what he heard? If you were in the crowd that day, what would you have "heard" from this? As Jesus is listening in your prayers, conversations, and interactions what is he amazed with and where might he be moving to improve your faith? What did these friends find when they returned to the house of the Centurion? Pray for your faith to grow and deepen in Jesus.
