Study Tools To Use DAY TO DAY STUDY GUIDE

Day 1 (Friday) - Read the Assigned Psalm/Chapter

Day 2 (Saturday) - Reread the assigned Psalm/ Chapter and identify key words; create symbols/markings chart on a 3x5 card or folded sheet of paper.

Day 3 (Sunday) - Reread the assigned Psalm / Chapter and Mark Key Words / Phrases using symbols chart from Day 2.

Day 4 (Monday) - Interrogate the text using the 5W's and an H provided. Write down your answers.

- Who are the main characters?
- What is the chapter about?
- When does this event or teaching take place?
- Where does this happen?
- Why is this being done or said?
- How did it happen?

Day 5 (Tuesday) - Review the text and responses from the 5W's and an H; complete the "Psalms at a Glance" chart (i.e., develop the theme).

Day 6 (Wednesday) - Make a list of what you learned from the text, a lists of "Lessons for Life" (LFL).

Day 7 (Thursday) - Breaking The Word With RHEMA - "Let's Talk About It" - Be prepared to discuss your findings from your personal daily studies.

Notes: Spend at least 15 - 20 minutes per day on your daily assignment. It easier to spend a little each day than to pack it all in one sitting.
