LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 10:8 Samuel told King Saul, "Go down ahead of me to Gilgal. I will surely come down to you to sacrifice burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, but you must **wait seven days until I come to you and tell you what you are to do**."

1 Sam.13:8-13 "Saul waited seven days, the time set by Samuel; but Samuel did not come to Gilgal, and Saul's men began to scatter. 9 So he said, "Bring me the burnt offering and the fellowship offerings." And **Saul offered up the burnt offering**. 10 Just as he finished making the offering, Samuel arrived... 11 "What have you done?" asked Samuel. Saul replied, "When I saw that the men were scattering, and that you did not come at the set time, and that the Philistines were assembling at Mikmash, 12 I thought, 'Now the Philistines will come down against me at Gilgal, and I have not sought the Lord's favor.' So I felt compelled to offer the burnt offering." 13 "**You have done a foolish thing**," Samuel said. "You have not kept the command the Lord your God gave you."

LESSONS FOR US:

- Trust in God's timing.
- Abraham and Sarah didn't. You can read about the trouble it caused them in Genesis chapters 16 and 21.
- Joseph waited in prison for two years for the chief cupbearer to remember him to Pharaoh.
 But it was probably worth the wait, because he was exalted to the second highest position in all of Egypt and was eventually reunited with his father, brothers and their families.
- Remember... "one day with the Lord is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day." 2 Peter 3:8. When you've been waiting for two years and it feels like forever, remember that two years is like two seconds to God. He sees a much bigger picture than we see. Trust His timing because He's never late.
