





Constitution Revision

The second major initiative that we believe the Lord is leading us toward is a revision of our governing documents.

This may or may not happen in 2022, but we want to begin the discussion and the rationale for proposing it.



Why? & What?

The major "Why" behind a constitution revision can be summed up in the headings, Affirm, Align, and Address. Affirm our beliefs, align ourselves with practices based upon them. Address issues that are important in our day. Assure that accountability is offered--All for the sake of magnifying Jesus by making disciples.

Affirm



Affirm what we believe. Using the historic confessions of faith and the wisdom of the collective body. We want to affirm our confession of faith especially in major areas of doctrine and practical areas of application in our culture.

Align

If we confess the Bible to be our authoritative and sufficient rule of faith and practice, it is only logical to seek to align our structure to follow its pattern.

Reorder

Word-order often communicates importance. We want to assure we address the most important matters first.

Remove

Remove items that are contradictory and those that go beyond the scriptures and the historic positions of orthodox Christianity.

Address Legal & Contemporary Matters

Prudence and best practices lead us to want to address some legal and contemporary matters in a biblically faithful, grace-filled manner.

Emphasize

Emphasize robust Biblical ecclesiology, church membership, and biblical- grace-filled, restorative church discipline.
