The Institution

Leader: We give thanks to God the Father, that our Savior, Jesus Christ, before he suffered gave us this memorial of his sacrifice until he comes again. For the Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "Take, eat. This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

People: For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes again.

The Teaching

- Leader: Most righteous God, we remember in this supper the perfect sacrifice, offered once for all on the cross, by our Lord Jesus Christ for the sin of the whole world.
- People: In the joy of the resurrection and in the expectation of his coming again, we offer ourselves to you as holy and living sacrifices.
- Leader: Send your Holy Spirit upon us, that the bread we break and the cup we bless may be to us the communion of the body and blood of Christ.
- People: Being joined together in him, may we attain the unity of the faith, and grow up in all things unto Christ, our Lord.
