I know many of you who were interested in what was presented by Grady Saturday morning were not able to attend, so I will give you my version of a quick summary.

#### **Some areas that we are trending really well in:**

- Clarifying our mission vision
- Advancing the Kingdom
- Involvement in ministries that meet needs
- Programs for children, parents, and older members

- Showing a desire to be together for worship and fellowship
- Core of committed loyal members

Graham Street Church of Christ is organizing a **Mission Trip to Bowling Green, KY** to help with Tornado Relief and Rebuilding. The trip is **March 5<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>** and will cost \$75 per person (\$50 for children 12 and under). This rate will cover lodging, meals (excluding travel days), and will help cover a portion of the building materials and other supplies.

All ages are welcome, but students in 8<sup>th</sup> grade and below are required to have an accompanying adult sponsor that is willing to take responsibility for the student while on the trip.

Our group will likely assist in 2 specific ways:

1.) **Neighborhood Rebuilding Projects:** could be jobs such as roofing, framing, hanging dry-wall, etc.

2.) **Volunteering at the Bowling Green Disaster Resource Center Storefront:** sorting and stocking supplies, checking “shoppers” in, helping “shoppers” get what they need, etc.

In addition, we will be staying at [Big Reedy Christian Camp](#) (just north of Bowling Green), and will need some volunteers to stay at camp each day to help prepare and cook meals, provide childcare for some of the younger children, etc.

If you cannot go but would like to donate towards the trip, earmark your offering with a note that it is for “Bowling Green Mission Trip.” Additionally, our Children's Offering during our weekly Sunday morning service is currently designated towards this trip.

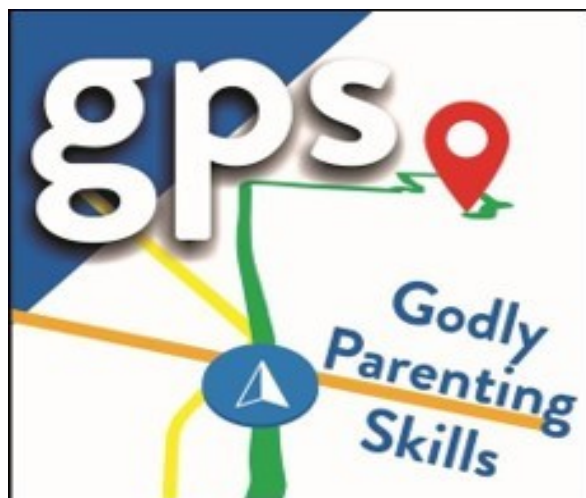

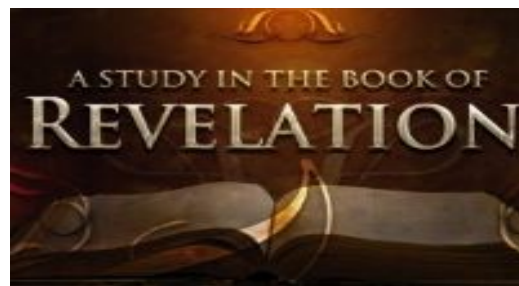
