

# Discovery Bible Study Guide

Disciple-making movements have been spreading around the world. As the Holy Spirit opens a door for the Word in a new place, Christian missionaries have found a simple way to use the Bible to train new disciples of Jesus. It is easily reproduced and focuses on obedience to Jesus Christ. In other words, the focus is on “teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you (Matthew 28:20).”

The group reads a passage, and asks:

1. What does this passage tell us about God?
2. What does this passage tell us about us/people in general?
3. What will you do this week in response to this passage?
4. Who is someone you can share it with this week?

The group does not move on from that passage until the majority can share how they applied questions 3 and 4 the previous week.

As the group grows, other questions can be added to address personal needs and follow up to lessons learned. For instance, a question at the beginning such as, “How were you able to put into practice last week’s passage, and what did you learn?” is important. Try this format in your triad or quad and let us know how that goes.
