Dear Friends,

As I write this, Russia has recognized two separatist areas of Ukraine and hostilities have begun to take place. We don't know what violence the coming days might bring.

The nation of Ukraine may seem distant and even unimportant to us, but its fate should be a central concern for all of us at this time. What is the issue here, anyway? Vladimir Putin recently noted in a public address that, "Modern Ukraine was entirely created by Russia." The irony is that "Russia" has its very origins in the nation we now call Ukraine.



The Russian civilization came into being over 1,000 years ago as the Kievan Rus. The Kievan Rus were centered around Kiev (now more generally referred to as Kyiv), the city which is now the capital of Ukraine. The Kievan Rus spread throughout the Eastern European region but was eventually broken apart by Mongol invasions and other forces. The Russian people developed further east around Moscow, while a somewhat different Slavic culture developed around Kyiv – becoming the Ukrainian people.

After centuries of foreign domination, Ukraine was first recognized as a separate entity after the 1917 Bolshevik Revolution. It was a Soviet republic until finally gaining independence in 1991. Now, Putin wants it back.

In terms of European nations, Ukraine is a giant. It is the second largest country in Europe by area, only behind Russia. It is roughly the size of Texas. Ukraine has 41 million people, over 70% of whom are believing Christians, mostly members of the Orthodox faith.

A great deal is at stake as Russia continues its aggression toward Ukraine, and the idea of this conflict drawing all of Europe into war should be enough to gravely concern all of us. It is our job as believers to pray for peace, especially in this pivotal place and time. Remember the nation of Ukraine as it faces this crisis, and pray that God will prevent yet another war in Europe.

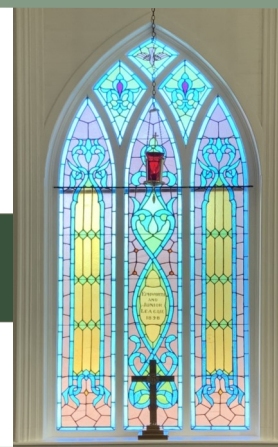
