Confession & Assurance ~

Leader: Today we lay before the cross the bag of coins, reward for treachery toward the Son of God. Judas handed Jesus over to the authorities, in greed and self-interest deliberately betraying his Lord. Our Scripture readings today remind us of the futility of seeking to satisfy ourselves by such paths.
