Greetings in the lovely name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We pray this finds you all faithful in the service of our great God and Saviour!!

In February, we excitedly started this year of Bible Institute at the Nebilyer Baptist Bible School. I am teaching 3 classes this year (Rightly Dividing, Homiletics, and Prophecy) and the other teachers are providing classes on the Book of Matthew, Book of Acts, Pastoral Epistles, and even a Tok Pisin Reading/Writing class (we have quite a few students that are from bush and are not very literate).

Last year, the 3 pastors who started this school in 2021, met with me and asked me to help them with this work by taking the role of principle. After much prayer, the Lord has given us all clear direction that I should take over the leadership of this school, which will allow the pastors to give the proper amount of attention to the churches they are pastoring and the new church plants we are working together to establish. These three men (Pastor Philemon Kapu, Pastor Sam Luru, and Pastor Vincent Wapuna) are all experienced in the work of the ministry, and I am so thankful the Lord has given me the opportunity to work alongside these men in the Bible School and in the starting of new churches in the Western Highlands.

One of these new churches is Resurrection Baptist Church in Keltiga, a little area just outside of town. I mentioned in a previous letter that I was covering the Wednesday night services at this new church plant in order to help Pastor Philemon and Pastor Sam who were struggling to find proper transportation to this area in the evenings. These 2 pastors have been rotating Sunday services between themselves, while I have been teaching through the book of 1 Corinthians on Wednesday evenings. Just a few weeks ago, the church members approached us about starting a Sunday night service (it is always a blessing when Christians want MORE church and not less).

We are excited to see the attendance of the church increase and to see the church members get excited about the work of the Lord. Please pray for this little church plant as they still do not have a pastor and have plenty of other needs (both physically and spiritually). We intend to begin bringing Bible School students to preach here later this year to give the students some practical experience in the ministry and we are praying the Lord will possibly call one of these men to take the work of pastor there.

Also, this month, we have started Bible classes here in town (Mt. Hagen) on Tuesday evenings at Temple Baptist Church (the church where I have been teaching adult Sunday School for the last 6 months). The churches in this town would like to start a Bible School, but we have all decided to start this work slowly by simply offering 2 classes one night a week to see who is serious about this work. We have had great attendance so far, with many coming from hours away and from neighboring provinces, and we are praying that this will continue in the days and months to come. Please pray for this endeavor as we would love to see this grow eventually into a full-blown Bible Institute for the Baptist churches in Mount Hagen.
