

### Dear Friends,

The first question I was asked at Presbytery was taken from this passage - a passage that I have always loved. It not only speaks of the magnificent glory of God (There's no need for a temple any longer. He's so bright that there's not even a need for a sun or moon!), but it also speaks of the wonder of the kings of the world...all the nations bringing their glory and honor into the city. Why is that important? If this city of God is altogether new, if the Lamb (our Lord Jesus) is at the center and it's his glory that we celebrate and enjoy, what need is there for earthly kings? Why would the nations even be considered or of any consequence?

It really is amazing to me that even in the closing chapters of the Bible, the

nations matter. In the early chapters of the Bible, Abraham is promised that "all the nations would be blessed" through him and his line. Jesus sent us out as disciples to all the nations. And now here, in Revelation, the nations still matter. The Bible continually points us to the importance of others all others, of all colors, all backgrounds, all geography.

Perhaps you heard of Pastor Dave's vision of Heritage Church being a "multi-ethnic, multigenerational church" that fills the sanctuary. It's a vision given to him (and us) by God. May we never cease praying that our Lord would make this vision our reality. May we never stop working to fulfill our calling to reach out to all ages...and all the nations.

### What you need:

- White index cards (at least six)
- Markers or colored pencils (red, orange, yellow, green, (red, orange, , , blue and brown)
- M&M's candies

### What you do:

- 1. On each card, write a group of people to pray for (family members, friends, teachers, sick people, etc.). Use a different color of writing utensil for each card.
- While sitting at a table, divide the M&M's among family members.
- 3. Spread out the cards and explain that each color represents a group of people to pray for. Have each family member choose one candy and consider who they'll pray for.
- 4. Designate one person to start praying aloud. Go around the circle, and have the last person close.
- 5. At the end of that round, eat those M&M's.
- Continue until vou've prayed for all the cards. (Make more, if you'd like!)

# Good Things Going on at Heritage EPC

This month, we're supporting the Central Coast Rescue Mission by bringing in food items and toiletries on Sunday, March 20th. Your donations will make a real difference in men's lives! What kind of an impact is the Central Coast Rescue Mission having?

In 2020 alone, 56 men participated in the program, 6 graduated from the life recovery program, 9 moved into stable housing, 15 became newly employed, 5,025 food boxes were given out, 35,365 meals were served, 5,086 articles of clothing were provided, 1,200 thanksgiving meals were served, and 625 toys were given to children at Christmas! But the story is in more than just the numbers. Lives are transformed as men move from addiction to recovery and from recovery into a life of serving Christ!



Hamburger Cheese Bake serves 24 (can cut this in half for a smaller family) This recipe is from Deedee's mom

> 16 oz. flat noodles 2 lbs. lean ground beef 2 15 oz. cans tomato sauce 1 T sugar 2 tsp. salt 1/2. tsp. garlic salt 1/2. tsp. pepper

2 cups cottage cheese 2 8 oz. cream cheese. (room temp.) 1 cup sour cream

2 bunches green onions with tops, diced. (approximately 1 cup) 1 green pepper chopped (approximately 1 cup) 1/2. cup shredded parmesan

Cook noodles until al dente and drain. Set aside. Cook beef until browned. Stir in tomato sauce, sugar, salt, garlic salt and pepper. Remove from heat. Combine cottage cheese, cream cheese, sour cream, green pepper and onions.

In a large bowl, combine noodles, sauce and cheese mixture. Spray a large casserole dish with non stick cooking spray, or you can butter it. Put the mixture into the dish and top with parmesan cheese.

Bake covered at 375 for 30 minutes. Uncover, let brown for about 15 more minutes. Ladies, the guys seem to love this hot dish!!
