#### AND HOMEWORK HELPERS

It has been a wonderful month! We are settling in to our routine and classroom roles!

The children have completed three lessons in February: Introductory English, colors, and fruit!

We are utilizing many methods using an ESL Kids program. The children are learning by writing, reading, and games.

Session 1 is 45 minutes, and includes signing them in and giving their name tag along with crayons, a pencil, and a packet of worksheets.

Their "Helper" greets them for one-on-one guidance with their homework and learning the

vocabulary from the lesson. During their 30 minute break, they enjoy their snack while watching a preschool Bible lesson.

The second session is interactive games and learning by reinforcing the vocabulary words.







We have grown to 39 students enrolled from infant through elementary age. Our largest attendance was 33 children in 1 night! Whew, we had so much fun learning colors that night that we caused disruption to the neighboring adult classes.

It is such a blessing to hear the children laugh, and learn! We pray the Lord will continue to refine us leaders and "Helpers".
