It was my plan to return to South Africa on March 16th, however, the Lord has allowed my plans to change. Last week, Brent and Selina Bergey (my co-laborers in South Africa) released the following news about their 17-year-old son, Nathaniel:

"March 7, 2022

This is by far the hardest post I have ever written.

It is cancer.

We will have the full pathology report tomorrow but it is a pediatric fast growing lymphoma, with a very rare presenting tumor.

He needs a bone marrow biopsy and immediate treatment.

Options for treatment are limited here. I will be flying back to the US with him as soon as he is medically stable enough to get on the plane. We have been told that days count.

I don't think I need to put into words how hard this is, for our family, but especially for this amazing young man, our son. He is already finding God in this, and while our hearts are breaking and we would take this from him if we could, we are so proud of him.

We are determined as a family to give God the glory.

As of March 13th, Selina and Nathaniel arrived in Winston-Salem, NC to seek a firm diagnosis and begin treatment. Since I am still in the states and available, I will be heading to North Carolina on March 16th. I will be helping Selina and Nathaniel through

the medical processes as well as providing support as needed over the next couple of weeks. Please pray that I will have clear direction and leading as far as how I can be of assistance medically, spiritually, and emotionally during this very difficult time.

Please keep Nathaniel, Brent, Selina, and the rest of the Bergey family in your prayers as they are separated by thousands of miles and also facing many unknowns. Pray for Little Fish Ministries and Abundant Life Baptist Church as these ministries continue to grow. May the Lord be glorified in and through all of these events!
