DB's Dabblings: "INTERGENERATIONAL SOWING AND REAPING"

We concluded last week's article with: We speak of our mission as a church in 3 words: **Rooted, Growing and Reaching.** This is impossible, if you are not sowing and reaping at the same time! One of the most important principles of "intergenerational youth and family ministry" is the principle that sowing and reaping are happening at the same time within the church family and out into the world.

In order to understand how we intergenerational sow and reap at same time, we must first understand what we are meaning by sowing and reaping. Here are some ways these terms are used in the Bible.

We obviously cannot reap or harvest if we don't sow or plant (Prov. 20:4), for we understand that if there is no seed in the ground, we can't expect a plant to grow out of the ground that will bear fruit. We also understand that it is God's plan that seeds will bring forth plants and future seeds according to their kind (Gen. 1:11-12; 1 Cor. 15:37-38). So as Eliphaz told Job, "As I have observed, those who plow evil and those who sow trouble, reap it." (Job 4:8). And according to Gal. 6:7-10 "Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith."

So, from these verses we can see that we need to sow the seeds of the Spirit that will reap the fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23). We need to sow the seeds of the Word of God so that it will bear the fruit of disciples of Christ (Luke 8). We need to sow the seeds of generosity and good deeds so that we might reap a harvest of righteousness and thanksgiving (2 Cor. 9:6-15). We need to show the seeds of righteousness so that righteousness will go before us and make a way for our footsteps in steadfast love (Psalms 85:11-13; Hos. 10:12). By doing this we will stay connected to Jesus as the vine and branches so that we will have a fruitful harvest for the Lord (John 15:1-11).

But how do you do the sowing and reaping of righteousness, good deeds, the fruit of the Spirit, the Word of God and Discipleship all at the same time and do it intergenerationally, or all generations at the same time? Well, that's next week. Until then, remember what Jesus said in John 9:4-5: "As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work. While I am in the world, I am the light of the world." Let's keep working together!




