**Day 15**

**The Promise**

**Galatians 3:16 NLT**

**Luke 1:55**

**SCRIPTURE:**

“God gave the promises to Abraham and his child. And notice that the Scripture ‘doesn’t say to his children,’ as if it meant many descendants. Rather, it says ‘to his child’ – and that, of course, means Christ.” [Gal 3:16]

“For he made this promise to our ancestors, to Abraham and his children forever.” [Luke 1:55 from Mary’s Magnificat]

**OBSERVATION:**

Mary recognizes the promise God gave Abraham. Abraham’s obedience and belief in God was what God used to reveal his promise that a descendant would bless all nations. Three-month pregnant, Mary is standing before her aunt Elizabeth, who is pregnant with John [the Baptist]. Everything seems to fall into place and Mary utters a beautiful song of praise and a realization of the fullness of God’s promise.

**APPLICATION:**

We have Jesus, the promise of God. Our obedience and belief are what spreads the word to all nations that Jesus is alive and offers forgiveness and a new start in life through faith in Jesus.

**PRAYER:**

Dear Jesus, I believe you are the promise. I want to be obedient to you. Please fill me with your Holy Spirit to work through me to spread your word. Please draw others to yourself through me.

**As you continue to Fast and Pray, consider the fullness of God’s promise. Jesus fulfilled the promise and soon he will return. This is good news! Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you with a sense of urgency to tell everyone you meet and to give you the words to say.**

**Day 16**

**Truth Overcomes the World**

**Luke 2:33 & 34**

**SCRIPTURE:**

“This child is destined for the falling and rising of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be opposed so that the inner thoughts of many will be revealed, and a sword will pierce your own soul too.”

**OBSERVATION:**

1. Jesus is destined to cause many to rise and many others to fall.
2. The deepest thoughts of many hearts will be revealed.
3. A sword will pierce Joseph & Mary’s very soul.

**APPLICATION:**

Truth was born into the world, and it shook up the system. I need to rely on Jesus - The Way, The Truth, and The Life - as my world and system gets turned upside down. It is going to pierce my heart and soul as I see the evil revealed because of the truth of Jesus.

**PRAYER:**

Dear Jesus, you make all things beautiful, but its going to get ugly first. Please help me to rely on you as the world goes crazy fighting against you – the Truth.

**As you continue to Fast and Pray, take comfort in the truth that Jesus continues to bring into the world. Jesus is the ultimate truth that overcomes the world. Pray for the people of Ukraine as they live through the horror of evil decisions made over their lives.**

**Day 17**

**Spiritual Milk**

**1 Peter 2:1-3 NLT**

**SCRIPTURE:**

“So get rid of all evil behavior. Be done with all deceit, hypocrisy, jealousy, and all unkind speech. Like newborn babies, you must crave pure spiritual milk so that you will grow into a full experience of salvation. Cry out for this nourishment, now that you have had a taste of the Lord’s kindness.”

**OBSERVATION:**

Salvation is a growth process, and we need nourishment like babies need milk. God's word is our milk. For a complete salvation meal, pair His word with His Grace drenched in the Holy Spirit - as a glass of milk with a plate of pancakes with bacon and eggs covered with the syrup of God Holy Spirit.

**APPLICATION:**

I need to come to the table empty of all wickedness, guile, hypocrisies, envy, and evil words. I need to be as hungry as a newborn, ready to take nourishment for my new life. I need to be ready to grow and change as I am fed by God’s Word and cleansed by His Grace and moved by the Holy Spirit.

**PRAYER:**

Dear God,

Please forgive me of any malice deceit and envy and even hypocrisy I have had over the last week. Help me to intentionally be aware of my actions and to be accountable also. Thank you for the forgiveness you have provided for me in the blood of Christ and please cleanse me with your Grace and feed me with your Word as if it is milk for a baby growing up in your salvation. I ask this because I have tasted the sweetness of your grace and your goodness. Please fill me with your presence God Holy Spirit and direct my path wherever you want me to go. I ask this from you in the name of your son and my Savior, Jesus Christ the resurrected one... Amen.

**As you continue to Fast and Pray, reflect on the sweetness of God’s grace and goodness. Have you experienced it? Drink in the word of God and grow in your salvation.**

**Thursday, March 24<sup>th</sup>**

**Day 18**

**Bridegroom**

**Luke 5:35**

**SCRIPTURE:**

“The days will come when the bridegroom will be taken away from them, and they will fast in those days.”

**OBSERVATION:**

Jesus knew what he was on earth for. The disciples knew he was the Messiah. Only Jesus knew the plan. When Jesus says bridegroom, it means a lot! It means promise. It means forever. It means going away to prepare a forever home for the bride and bridegroom.

**APPLICATION:**

Jesus is still preparing a forever home for us. Now is the time to fast and pray. The world needs Jesus, and we need the strength and courage to witness.

**PRAYER:**

Dear Lord, help me to focus my attention on you as I fast and pray. Help me to seek your Holy Spirit for the strength and courage to tell the world about you. Please love through me. Please open my eyes to the needs of those around me that I may open my mouth to witness of your love.

**As you continue to Fast and Pray, consider what the Bride of Christ would be doing as she waits for her Bridegroom. How would she prepare? What would she be focusing on?**

**Day 19**

**Understanding God's Word**

**Psalm 119:99 & 100 NKJV**

**SCRIPTURE:**

"I have more understanding than all my teachers, for your testimonies are my meditation. I understand more than the ancients, because I keep your precepts."

**OBSERVATION:**

Many times, in this chapter the psalmist asks God to reveal the meaning of scripture to him. The psalmist also realizes that he needs to meditate and obey God's word to have understanding of God's word. This scripture also shows us that the Holy Spirit can give us understanding beyond what human teaching can show us.

**APPLICATION:**

In need to spend more time reading and studying God's word each day asking the Holy Spirit to reveal to me the hidden gems that He has placed in His word. I need to be obedient to His word so that sin will not hinder my understanding.

**PRAYER:**

Lord, I pray for more desire to spend more time reading and studying your word each day. Give me the understanding that I need from your word to live my life so that it glorifies you. Give me the strength I need to be obedient to your ways and the faith that you can teach me beyond human wisdom. Thank you for the blessings that you give me each day, you are truly worthy to be praised. Amen.

**SCRIPTURE:**

**APPLICATION:**



**SCRIPTURE:**

**OBSERVATION:**

Our God is one and we are called to be one body of believers in Christ, bound together by one Spirit. Jesus is our Lord for the one baptism upon us is the Holy Spirit of God. He resides inside us, and all through us and is all around us. He is above us all in sovereignty and love.

**APPLICATION:**
