HYMN OF THE DAY: Our hymn of the day is *Glory Be to Jesus*. This hymn praises Jesus for pouring out his life-blood. In verse two, we learn what we gained from that sacrifice, grace and life eternal. In verse three, we learn that the sacrifice of Jesus was sufficient for all the world's redemption. Verse four contrasts the blood of Abel, whose blood in Genesis cried out for vengeance, with the blood of Jesus, that cries out for our pardon. The sacrifice of Christ makes him worthy of all praise and adoration. "Praise the precious blood!"

A WORD: Our Old Testament reading is a song that praises God for the gift of salvation. In the epistle reading, we hear how God accomplished our salvation. He made him (Christ) to be sin who knew no sin, that in him we might become the righteousness of God. Because all of our sin has been placed on Christ, God no longer counts our sins against us. Everyone in Christ is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

Our Gospel reading is the parable of the two sons (often called the parable of the prodigal son). This parable raises the question, "Who belongs to the family of God and why?" The answer is that we belong to God's family, not because of what we do, but because of grace.

FROM THE PASTOR: New hymnals arrived at Peace this week. These hymnals contain the same songs as the old ones, with a few additions. I would like to thank Yvette, Cheryl, and Jan for their hard work on this project, along with everyone who contributed to the purchase of the hymnals. These hymnals will bless the church with the gift of music for years to come. We will dedicate them next Sunday.
