DB's Dabblings: "Practically Intergenerational"

In my sermon series from Deuteronomy and in the GPS Class I have been dealing with the theories and theology of "intergenerational ministry" throughout the church body and as applied primarily to Youth Ministry. It's time to get more practical. I have asked Sterling Doty to help me with that in this week's sermon, "Intergenerational Teamwork." I thought it might help to draw an analogy of what we mean by intergenerational ministry by comparing it to the development of a football team. As the coach of the State Champion Stephenville Yellow Jackets and the Texas 4A Coach of the Year, I thought he is more qualified than most to make this comparison, wouldn't you say? I am very excited and look forward to his presentation Sunday, April 3.

A key factor in what we are talking about is found in Eph. 4:16, "From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work." Now, I don't read that passage as saying all the adult males, or all the members over 17, or all the adult members assigned to a leadership position. The whole body works together to help the church grow in love and to look like Christ. And every member (including the teens and children!) has a role to play in that effort. In football that's teamwork! And if you back up in the context in verses 11-13, you find it is the role of the leaders of the church to equip the members to cause the church to function this way.

Ephesians 4:11-13 "So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ."

You might ask, "Well, what does that look like?". Let me illustrate it with a Facebook Post by Kristin Bundy, the Youth Minister's wife at the Altamesa Church of Christ in Ft Worth (a church that is applying the principles of intergenerational youth ministry):

This morning Jaxon helped lead worship.

This morning Brooklyn helped to teach our 3-5 year olds.

This morning during worship, Tatum helped in T3, our children's worship.

The leaders of our church have the wisdom to include our youth in all aspects of worship and our church ministries.

Often during worship, our youth group section looks smaller than it really is because our teens are scattered throughout the building serving in different ways. You can see teens in the AV booth, serving Neighborhood Needs, teaching and helping in various ways in our Children's Ministry, and leading worship in some capacity.

Our leaders and our congregation do not view our teens as passive members of the church idly waiting their turn to serve when they become adults, but instead they see them as active members of the body who have gifts to use now. It's beautiful.

Here are some of the responses she got:

And I love how my kids feel their importance as they serve and are proactive about getting to church on time so that they do not leave a gap. They love serving on Sundays! I love, love this!!!!!!

What we love most about it!! Thanks to you and Nate, our kids are not consumers but active members of the Body!!

Yes! 📆 this is beautiful. This morning, Gisela was working nursery and Gavin was working media. Every member of the body of Christ is important.






