Aloha MBC 'Ohana,

As I write this month's Pastor's Corner article, I am grieved over the reports of the Russian invasion of Ukraine. On the one hand, we know that due to the state of man's depraved hearts, wars and rumors of wars will continue until Christ returns and ends all war once and for all. On the other hand, we are shocked and saddened by the brazen attacks and senseless violence taking place before our eyes. As all of this takes place, I am encouraged by a quote I read from Paul Chitwood, President of the IMB. He posted the following in a statement today:

"In times of uncertainty, crisis, and disaster, we see the Lord actively at work drawing people to Himself. Many people are more open to spiritual conversations and ask questions about the truth and peace that is found in Christ alone when they face uncertain situations. Pray with us that Jesus Christ would be glorified through today's global crises, particularly the crisis in Eastern Europe, and that Southern Baptists would remain vigilant in meeting the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of all peoples."

My dear church family, I ask you to commit yourself to prayer. Pray with me that God's will would be done, that the believers there would be protected and emboldened to share their faith, and that those who do not know Christ would come to know Him. As believers, we know that our help comes from God and that no one can do anything that God has not allowed, as we believe that He is totally sovereign and always has a plan to work His will and His way to completion. The IMB has put out the following prayer guide to help us be focused in our prayers. I encourage you to pray through this list:

- 1. The people of Ukraine as tension builds on the Ukraine-Russia border. Pray for strength, courage and perseverance as their home is threatened by imminent conflict.
- 2. Safe passages out of conflict zones for displaced populations.
- 3. Government officials to lead with wisdom in this tense time.
- 4. The estimated 4 million displaced people who will be forcibly removed from their homes. Pray that in the face of conflict, they will find psychological, emotional and spiritual healing from this trauma.
- 5. Soldiers on both sides of this conflict to be safe from harm.
- 6. Local churches, relief workers and humanitarian aid organizations to care for what could be a massive wave of displaced peoples in Ukraine.
- 7. Disciples Church in L'viv, Ukraine, and its church plant in Bryukhovychi. Many of the people there are displaced from the East. Pray for peace for these believers as they had hoped this conflict from eight years ago was over and now, they are facing it again.
- 8. The Ukrainian Baptist Theological Seminary as it wrestles with how to assist its students in this time of crisis.
- 9. Ukrainian believers as they seek to be a light in the darkness.
- 10. Ukrainians who have never heard the gospel to have an opportunity to experience the hope of Jesus.
- As we pray, we see the hand of God move. May you be encouraged in your prayer time, and may our faith be strengthened as God works out His will in the world we are called to preach the gospel to. May God bless you as you enter into a new month of life and ministry here at MBC.
