The Message of Easter: When Being Unraveled Binds Us Together

During this Lenten Season, we have focused on some poignant questions:

What happens when our world falls apart?

How do we press on when our tightly knit plans unravel into loose threads?

What do we become when our identity or the path we're on becomes undone?

What if all of this is not the end we fear it will be?

These questions often are the reality that many of us are facing. The truth is, especially in the past couple of months, our world seems to have become undone: The devastation in Ukraine, runaway inflation, economic uncertainties, health challenges, etc. These are things that many are grappling with. Our faith and the stories of scripture can have a tremendous impact on our pathway to healing.

As we look forward to Holy Week and Easter - the most powerful story of unraveling comes to life. For the disciples, in a few shore days, their world came undone. For Jesus, the embodiment of love and salvation, the story cost him his life.

Just when everything seemed darkest, the heart and soul of Easter shone through. The very act of becoming unraveled paved the way to bringing the church together.

It was on March 15, 2020 that we closed our church doors in the face of a terrifying pandemic. None of us knew that it would lead to such isolation, frustration and disconnect that would last for two years. We had hoped that we could gather by Easter that year, but it was not to be so. So began creative ways of trying to be the church in this difficult season.

This past Sunday, for the first time in 2 years, we were able to provide communion in our traditional way: Gary Peterson lovingly baked the bread from scratch, and our beloved Altar Guild tenderly filled the individual glasses of wine. Many were moved to tears as they came to the altar to receive Christ's body and blood. As we worshipped together in a full church, without masks, our faces shone.

9:00 a.m. -The Cry of the Whole Congregation: A reader's theater of the entry into Jerusalem and the crucifixion story - led by our talented and faithful members.

Maundy Thursday

7:00 pm - A celebration of First Communion for some of our younger children and families - it has been three years since we've been able to share together in this milestone.

Good Friday

10:00 am - Family Gathering - crafts and participation in the reenactment of this story.

7:00 pm - Service of Readings - of Mary, as she watched her son suffer and die.

Easter Sunday

8:00 am - A short outdoor service and procession into the sanctuary.

9:00 am - Festival Easter Worship - Traditional worship featuring our choir.

10:30 am. - Contemporary Easter Service - Celebration music with our Trinity band.

We hope that you can join us in worship and celebration, as we boldly proclaim the love that binds us together; even in, and especially in, times of unraveling.



In April Trinity's Second Sunday Offering will be for the Tapestries of Life ministry in Mexico. Trinity members have supported this outreach orphanage ministry for many years and the orphanage is slated to open in April 2022. This 250-bed facility will be home and school as well as church to the orphans. Supply needs are continuous, especially the need for food, school supplies, clothing and shoes for the children, laundry and toiletries as well as other household supplies. Diane John from Trinity has spent the last several months in Texas, across the border from the orphanage helping to organize, check in visitors and assist to meet code regulations with the Mexican government to help ensure the facility's opening. Please pray for this ministry and its opening of the orphanage so that children can get off the street. The Second Sunday offering will be collected at Trinity on April 10th. Money donated will be matched dollar to dollar from the Pearl Nelson Bequest Fund. Thank you for your generosity.

Just in the Chisago Lakes area, there are three churches with open music positions. Additionally, with the approval of the 2022 budget, and no money being budgeted for a Music Director, the Church council has decided to PAUSE looking for a candidate to fill this position until funding for this position can be identified. The Church Council will re-evaluate the job description and explore new options for advertising this position to target a larger candidate pool, with hopes that the right candidate can be found when the funding is attained. Trinity Building Renovation Committee Update

The Trinity Building Renovation Committee met twice in March. We reviewed the architectural plan from Progressive Architecture, made changes and additions, and sent it back to the



architect to update. Our next step is to meet with the architect to go over our building requirements and come up with some budgetary costs. The Trinity building energy audit being done by the non-profit **EnerChange** is expected to be completed in April or May. The energy audit may also provide us with the feasibility, cost, and payback for installing solar panels, although no decision has been made on installing them. At this writing, we are still waiting to hear back from the County building inspector as to whether expanding the building footprint will require the installation of a fire sprinkler system? As Trinity Lutheran rolls out their new Website, we are expecting to upload building renovation information for the congregation to view as well as to start accepting your comments and feedback. 

COMMUNITY FOR CREATION CARE (CCC)

Earth Day is celebrated every year on April 22. It is a day held to promote environmental awareness and calls for the protection of our planet. At first, Earth Day was celebrated across the United States, then starting in 1990, Earth Day went global and is now celebrated in more than 193 countries each year.



The history of Earth Day 2022 dates back to 1970 when it was founded by Senator Gaylord Nelson to promote ecology and the respect for life on

the planet as well as to encourage awareness of the growing problems of air, water and soil pollution.

It is usually celebrated with outdoor activities such as planting trees, picking up roadside trash, and conducting various programs for recycling and conservation. Some people are encouraged to sign petitions to governments calling for stronger or immediate action to stop global warming.

At Trinity, the Community for Creation Care Committee, CCC, continues to work on environmental issues in partnership with the congregation. We are working on projects that will involve the youth and offer educational and practical opportunities that will have a positive impact on our environment. Thank you to everyone who was able to attend the Annual Meeting and for all your questions and comments. The Executive Committee has made some commitments for some better communication in 2022, so you will be seeing more financial updates throughout the year. Our bookkeeper, Twyla, has been working hard since the Annual Meeting, getting year to date totals updated. Here is where Trinity ended up in January.

TOTAL EXPENSES \$47,108.31 \$45,043.38

INCOME LESS EXPENSES -\$3,378.27 -\$11,751.91

So far in 2022, we have not had to transfer any money from the Annuity, Bequest or Reserves.

Trinity is still working through the External Audit process. Currently we are completing a questionnaire and providing more documentation to the auditors for their review. Trinity should receive a report of the audit by the end of June.
