LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 15:3 "Now go, attack the Amalekites and totally destroy all that belongs to them. Do not spare them; put to death men and women, children and infants, cattle and sheep, camels and donkeys."

1 Samuel 15:19-21 "Why did you not obey the Lord? Why did you pounce on the plunder and do evil in the eyes of the Lord?" ²⁰ "But I did obey the Lord," Saul said. "I went on the mission the Lord assigned me. I completely destroyed the Amalekites and brought back Agag their king. ²¹ The soldiers took sheep and cattle from the plunder, the best of what was devoted to God, in order to sacrifice them to the Lord your God at Gilgal."

LESSONS TO LEARN:

- Don't deceive yourselves.
 - When Samuel asked Saul, "Why did you not obey the Lord?" Saul said, "But I did obey the Lord." In his very next breath Saul said, "I completely destroyed the Amalekites and brought back Agag their king."
 - Some how **Saul had deceived himself** into thinking destroying all of the Amalekites, **but one**, was equal to destroying **all** of the Amalekites.
 - Some how **Saul had deceived himself** into thinking destroying all of the animals, **except the best**, was equal to destroying **all** of the animals.
- James 1:22 says, "Do not merely listen to the word, and so **deceive yourselves**. **Do what it says**." If we do not obey God's word, we are deceiving ourselves into thinking we are pleasing God, when in reality... we are not. Let us be careful not to deceive ourselves.
